# CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT SCOTT M. TONTEGODE

Chief Master Sergeant Scott M. Tontegode is the command chief master sergeant of the 155th Air Refueling Wing in Lincoln, Nebraska. He is the primary advisor to the commander and senior staff on all enlisted issues including the health, welfare, morale, mentorship and discipline of more than 800 Airman assigned to the wing. Chief Tontegode is charged with the professional development and proper utilization of the enlisted force. He ensures the unit is trained, properly equipped and ready to complete state and local missions.

Chief Tontegode enlisted in the Nebraska Air National Guard in May of 1987 and graduated from the Refrigeration Specialist Course at Sheppard Air Force Base in January of 1988. Chief Tontegode has held positions at the 155<sup>th</sup> Air Refueling Wing in Civil Engineering, Medical and most recently with the Wing Staff as the Wing Occupational and Weapons Safety Manager. Chief Tontegode has been involved in developing Air Force and Air National Guard safety courses and has instructed over 1500 students in 26 states on safety and health regulations and safety concepts. Chief Tontegode deployed to Mississippi in support of Joint Task Force Katrina where he was part of a specialized health and safety team. He has also deployed to Antarctica as an Occupational Safety Specialist in support of OPERATION DEEP FREEZE and has been involved in numerous state activations due to natural disasters.
